The Buncrana shore-path is a 4.5 km (one way) traffic free walk which follows the shoreline of Lough Swilly between Buncrana and Stragill Strand. It is gently undulating path which passes quiet beaches, old forts and a number of sites of historical interest. Wildlife is abundant and the views in all directions are superb.

4.5 km one way - 9 km return

Height gain: 20 metres

Estimated Time: 2 - 3 hours

Terrain: Trail is generally flat with a smooth

> surface but with occasional gentle slopes, some short sections of gravel surface and a section of sandy beach at

Stragill Strand.
